

Air Madagascar Windsurf Challenge

10-17 September 2005

The Air Madagascar Windsurf Challenge is a combination of an international windsurf contest and a trip to a very wild and exotic place.

This event will take place in Sakalava Bay in the north of Madagascar, close to Diego Suarez and we will bring together 8 of the top 20 windsurfers in the world:

Ricardo Campello (Brazil), **Robby Swift** (England), **Thomas Traversa** (France), **Victor Fernandez** (Spain), **Boujmaa Guilloul** (Morocco), **Julien Taboulet** (France), **Klaas Voget** (Germany) and **Yann Sune** (France).

Featuring a freestyle competition in the lagoon and wave riding on the reef, the competitors will judge each other in this unique event.

During the 7 days, the competitors will share adventure and discovery: crossing the Emeraude Sea with the fishermen, bivouacs on an island, fishing, trips, meeting with local communities and finishing on Friday 16th of September with the big fiesta for the winners in Diego Suarez at the Tropical Disco.
